





### What are Spark Waves®?



Spark Waves®
highly effective shock waves that initiate biological regeneration
processes at the cellular level



Generating principle spark gap in water quench



- Spark Wave™ characteristics:
  - High peak pressure (up to 100 MPa)
  - Fast pressure rise (<10 ns)</li>
  - Short lifecycle (<10 ms)</li>
  - Positive and negative pressure phase




# Biological effect of Spark Waves™ in wound healing



Stimulation of healing process on a cellular level by:

- Bactericidal effect (in vitro)
- Reduction of inflammation processes
- Bioengineering & Tissue Regeneration
- Migration of stem cells





# Biological effect of Spark Waves® in wound healing – animal model

Stimulation of healing process at the cellular level by:

- Promotion of body's own production of growth factors (VEGF, eNOS, PCNA etc.)
- Promotion of blood circulation and development of new blood vessles (angiogenesis)

#### Induced angiogenesis






**Before ESWT**

Before and 8 weeks after SWT / 3 SWT sessions applied





# Spark Wave® therapy for burn injuries



**Electrical burn,** wound size 6x2x6cm, persistent for 3 months

Before and after SWT treatment / 4 sessions in total applied over a period of 28 days




#### **Burn injury**

Before and after 7 weeks / 4 SWT sessions applied in total








#### Post operative healing disorder

Before, after 2 weeks and after 17 weeks / 2 sessions of SWT applied






#### Trauma injury

Before, after 1 week, after 2 weeks and after 8 weeks / 4 SWT sessions applied








#### Trauma injury by rotating ship's propeller

Before SWT, after 3 weeks, after 11 weeks and after 26 months / in total 6 SWT applied






#### **Healing disorder**

94 year old female, para-venously applied infusion and 2 septical revisions, infection with penicilin-resistant staphylococcus aureus, chronic COPD, chromic lymphatic leukemia

Before, after 2 weeks, after 4 weeks and after 7 weeks / in total 4 SWT applied







#### Trauma injury / necrotic finger

Before, after 7 weeks and after 7 months / in total 7 SWT treatments applied






### Spark Wave® therapy for trauma wounds – scar treatment








53y, male, 11 months after surgery (plating distal radius fracture) 6 treatments (3600 pulses in total / ~ 11 minutes – 4 months)

Before and 6 weeks after SWT / in total 2 SWT applied









#### Diabetic foot ulcer after toe amputation

Bi-weekly treatment for two months








#### Diabetic foot ulcer after surgery

67 year old male, diabetic, neuropathy








#### Diabetic foot ulcer

Before, after 6 weeks and after 12 weeks / 6 sessions of SWT applied








Diabetic foot ulcer to the bone, infected

Weekly treatment for two months







Diabetic foot ulcer after surgical intervention 71 years old, female, diabetic 5 SWT treatments in total, 2.500 impulses

### Spark Wave® therapy for Pressure Ulcer / Decubitus




**Decubitus ulcer** developed after surgery of an osteosarcoma where patient suffered a lesion of his right sciatic nerve, 39 year old male

Before SWT, after 2 weeks, after 12 weeks and after 18 months / in total 5 SWT applied





### Spark Wave® therapy for Pressure Ulcer / Decubitus




#### Infected decubitus ulcer

Before, after 14 weeks and after 2 years / Weekly SWT sessions for 6 months





### Spark Wave® therapy for Venous Ulcer



**Venous ulcer on left lower leg**, > 5months, 71 year-old female Before and after 2 treatments / treatment every 2 weeks for 8 weeks in total
